Nikos Tsotsolas is an Assistant Professor (Business Administration Dept.) at University of West Attica. He holds a Diploma in Production Engineering and Management from the Technical University of Crete, Greece (1997), a M.Sc. in Operational Research (2001) from the same University and a PhD in Statistical Science (2009) from University of Piraeus. He had received a 3 year scholarship from Greek Ministry of Education for performing field research on Post-Optimality Analysis (multiple and near-optimal solutions) in Linear Systems. From 2006 to date he is member of the Board of the Hellenic Operational Research Society (HELORS).
